This Cookie Notice describes the cookies that are used on our website portfolio (including but not limited to, <https://ags-systems.com/> and all sub-sites, together referred to as the “**Website**”) and the personal information that may be collected through these cookies. ### 1. Cookies

To make our Website simpler to use and navigate, we sometimes place small data files on your computer or device. These are known as cookies.

A cookie is a small text file that a website saves on your computer or mobile device when you visit the site. It enables the website to remember your actions and preferences (such as login, language, font size and other display preferences) over a period of time, so you don't have to keep re-entering them whenever you come back to the site or browse from one page to another.

Most websites you visit will use cookies in order to improve your user experience by enabling that website to 'remember' you, either for the duration of your visit (using a 'session cookie') or for repeat visits (using a 'persistent cookie').

Cookies do lots of different jobs, like letting you navigate between pages efficiently, storing your preferences, and generally improving your experience of a website. Cookies make the interaction between you and the website faster and easier. If a website doesn't use cookies, it will think you are a new visitor every time you move to a new page on the site – for example, when you enter your login details and move to another page it won't recognise you and it won't be able to keep you logged in.

We use cookies to make the Website work better for you and because they are essential to the usage of our Website. You can control and/or delete cookies as you wish – for details, see <http://www.aboutcookies.org>.

You can delete all cookies that are already on your computer and you can set most browsers to prevent them from being placed. If you do this, however, you may have to manually adjust some preferences every time you visit our Website and some services and functionalities may be inaccessible or not work properly.
